Obituary

Deborah Friedman 1946 - 2023

AAMS member Deborah "Debby" Friedman died October 27, 2023, at her home in New York City. She was 77 years old.

She was one of the first female members of the Collectors Club of New York, joining in 1970. In 1983, she co-founded Copaphil, the Colombia-Panama Philatelic Study Group and served as its president for about 20 years.

One area of her philatelic collecting interests was Colombian aerophilately. She did many hours of research and exhibited her collection. Her collection was offered in a 2007 "name" sale by Cherrystone Auctions.

In 2011, she was honored with the APS Kehr Award for her contributions to help guarantee the future of the hobby. She was well-known for her tireless efforts to encourage and mentor youth and beginner exhibitors.
